DAY 1 | VIP Welcome to Nairobi

You'll be met on arrival, assisted through immigration + customs, and escorted to the landmark *Fairmont Norfolk Hotel*.

DAY 2 | Into the Maasai Mara

Visit the Giraffe Center and dine at *Tamambo Karen Blixen*, set on the author's homestead. Then fly into the Maasai Mara and check in to the 5-star *Fairmont Mara Safari Club*, set on a bend in the Mara River. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 3 | In a hot air balloon

The sun's rays are just beginning to flicker across the sky as you float silently above the game-filled expanse of the Maasai Mara! After lunch, luxuriate in the ambience of the *Fairmont Club* before an exciting safari drive and a chance to spot the Big Five. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 4 | Onward to Amboseli

Enjoy a morning game drive before your safari flight to Amboseli National Park. With Kilimanjaro providing a dramatic backdrop, Amboseli is heralded for its quintessential African landscapes. Spend two nights at *Ol Tukai Lodge*, a great place to see elephants.

DAY 5 | In the shadow of Mt. Kilimanjaro

Morning and afternoon game drives offer a chance to see Amboseli's vast elephant herds as well as lion, cheetah and zebra.

DAY 6 | The Great Rift Valley

Cross into Tanzania and journey through the Great Rift Valley to Lake Manyara. Check in to the deluxe *Lake Manyara Serena Lodge*. A late afternoon game drive offers your first chance to see the Park's abundant wildlife.

DAY 8 | Inside the crater

The grasslands of Ngorongoro are easy for officials to patrol, resulting in healthy populations of endangered species like black rhino and cheetah. Descend to the crater floor this morning for unmatched wildlife viewing with our expert safari guide. Our lodge will provide a packed lunch so you

After breakfast, we'll take you overland to Tarangire National Park to check in to *Lemala Mpingo Ridge Lodge*. Tarangire remains off the main safari circuit, offering a more private safari experience. Enjoy your first afternoon game drive—followed by sundowner cocktails and an elegant dinner at the lodge. MEALS BHLHD

DAY 3 | On safari in Tarangire

Thrill to morning and afternoon game drives with our expert safari guides. The nearby Tarangire River is a magnet for wildlife, and the Park is heralded for its abundance, especially its large herds of elephants and superb birdlife. Lions, leopards, and cheetahs are also regularly spotted. This evening, delight in an exciting night safari. MEALS BHLHD

DAY 4 | To Ngorongoro Crater

This morning's visit to a local school affords memorable insight into the challenges and rewards of life in Tanzania. Continue to *Lemala Ngorongoro*; perched on the crater's rim, our tented safari camp offers views of the world's largest intact



caldera. After lunch, visit a Maasai village. This evening, a chief's son shares personal insight into the Maasai culture. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 5 | First on the crater floor

With its vast expanses of open grassland surrounded by steep cliffs, Ngorongoro Crater (a) is abundant with wildlife including rare species like black rhino and cheetah. Our camp enjoys a prime location by the Lemala Crater Access Route; you'll descend quickly this morning for a spectacular game drive before other visitors have even arrived on the crater floor!

DAY 6 | The Central Serengeti

At Olduvai Gorge, learn about 1.8 million-year-old fossil discoveries, then continue into the vast expanse of the Central Serengeti (a), unequaled for its concentration of wildlife – including the Big 5. Enjoy a game drive before sundowner cocktails and an elegant dinner at the exclusive *Lemala Ewanjan*.

DAY7 | Ballooning over the Serengeti

Marvel at this morning's hot air balloon safari, then touch down for a champagne breakfast and a morning game drive. Enjoy time to relax at camp before a late afternoon safari drive that promises more encounters with the stunning animals that roam the Serengeti. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 8 | Tracking the Great Migration across the plains

DAY 1 | Our VIP Arrival in Nairobi

You'll be met on arrival, assisted through immigration and customs, and then escorted to the landmark *Fairmont Norfolk Hotel*.

DAY 2 | Under Kilimanjaro's gaze

Setting out from Nairobi offers your first game-viewing drive as we take you to Amboseli National Park. Arrive in time for lunch and an afternoon game drive at *Ol Tukai*. In the shadow of mighty Kilimanjaro, Africa's highest peak, our classic safari lodge is heralded as one of the best places in Africa to observe elephants.

DAY 3 | On safari at Amboseli

Morning and afternoon game drives in our safari vehicles explore Amboseli's varied terrain, home to wildebeest, zebra, buffalo, giraffe, leopard and cheetah. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 4 | Onward to the Ol Pejeta Private Conservancy

After a quick safari flight to Nairobi, continue overland into the scenic Mt. Kenya Highlands to the luxurious *Sweetwaters Tented Camp* where you'll have lunch before a game drive. Surrounded by the pristine calm of the private OI Pejeta Conservancy, this region boasts a greater game density than any other park in Kenya and is the largest black rhino sanctuary in all of East Africa. DAY 5 | Morning + afternoon game drives

Dedicated to preserving Kenya's rich wildlife, OI Pejeta shelters rare endangered species like northern white rhino, Grevy's zebra and Jackson's hartebeest. And with high predator densities, today's game drives will be thrilling! Situated on the Conservancy, the Sweetwaters Chimpanzee Sanctuary is the only place in Kenya where you'll see this remarkably intelligent species. A special Lion Tracking Expedition takes you in search of these big cats as you learn to follow clues from paw prints to spoor. MEALS B+L+D

DAY 6 | Into the Maasai Mara

Take off from the airstrip for aerial views of the Great Rift Valley. As you sweep over the vast expanse of the Maasai Mara, you'll have a chance to look down upon vast herds of grazing animals and packs of predators that roam in the same super-abundance that thrilled Teddy Roosevelt over a century ago! On arrival, we'll take you to the elegant *Fairmont Mara Safari Club* for lunch and an exciting afternoon game drive. Meals B+L+D

DAY 7 | Wildlife of the Maasai Mara
