

OCT 9 | Welcome to Cairo

Upon arrival, you'll be met inside passport control, your visa will be provided and we'll accompany you through formalities, pick up your luggage and chauffeur you to your Club guestroom at the 5-star *Fairmont Nile Hotel*. We'll casually gather this evening to get acquainted at an open bar and light dinner. MEALS D

OCT 10 | Between the Paws of the Sphinx

Off limits to visitors, this morning finds us between the Paws of the Sphinx for a private field presentation with our expert Egyptologist. We'll also spend time at the Great Pyramids (2) and have lunch in a delightful restarant garden before entering the Grand Egyptian Museum. We'll be guided through the collection and when the Museum closes, we'll enjoy a private dinner there with light music. MEALS B+L+D

OCT 11 | Onward to Alexandria

We arrive in Alexandria just in time for an outdoor seaside lunch at the city's yacht club. Then, tour the Alexandria castle and the Catacomb of Kom El Shoqafa. At Pompey's Pillar, we'll discover a monolithic column that was erected in 300 AD to honor the Roman Emperor Diocletian. Enjoy dinner and a 2-night stay at the *Four Seasons Hotel*. MEALS B+L+D

OCT 12 | Exploring Alexandria

After breakfast, we'll tour the extraordinary Bibliotheca Alexandrina, a new striking landmark. Following lunch, visit the ancient Roman Amphitheater and also the seaside Montazah Palace and Royal Gardens. This evening, we'll join for dinner at the Four Seasons. MEALS B+L+D

OCT 13 | Return to Cairo

After breakfast, we depart Alexandria to visit Memphis (20), the ancient capital, and see the colossus of Ramses II and the Alabaster Sphinx. In nearby Sakkara, you'll be amazed by King Zoser's Step Pyramid, and the 4,000-yearold Tomb of Mehu. Following lunch, be guided through the new National Museum of Egyptian Civilization and its fantastic underground display of the mummies and sarcophagi of Egypt's twenty most prominent pharaohs. We'll arrive at the *Fairmont* before gathering for dinner at the edge of the Nile. MEALS B+L+D

OCT 14 | Board the Philae + Karnak + Luxor

After an early breakfast, fly to Luxor to board the Oberoi Philae. In mid-afternoon, our Egyptologist will guide us to the great Karnak Temple (.). Stand before its massive pillars and admire its grand Hypostyle Hall, the largest of any temple in the world. We'll continue along the Avenue of the Sphinxes to the nearby Luxor Temple 🛞 built in the 14th century BCE. Luxor's temple walls are embellished with beautiful carvings of the Gods of Karnak accompanied by a festival procession of priests, musicians, dancers and sacred cows. Our Egyptologist will provide a fascinating commentary on the culture and belief systems in this period of ancient Egypt. We'll return to the ship for Tea and with time to refresh before this evening's welcome cocktail reception and dinner. MEALS B+L+D

OCT 15 | West Bank + Valley of Kings

We head out early to the Valley of the Kings (2), where 64 ancient Egyptian rulers lie buried. Today's touring includes the famed tomb of King Tutankhamen. At Deir el-Medina, we'll learn about the artisans and laborers who built the tombs 3,000 years ago. Like guards along the road to the Valley of Kings, we'll also see the Colossi of Memnon. Return to the ship for lunch and set sail for the south, transiting the Lock of Esna and timeless scenes of life along the Nile. MEALS B+L+D

OCT16 | Edfu + Kom Ombo

We stop in Edfu to visit the Temple of Horus; rich in design and ingenious in construction. The amazing quality of every element attests to the importance of the falcon-headed Sun God, Horus. We return to ship and enjoy lunch as our luxury vessel continues its journey. Following Afternoon Tea, we'll step off to explore the Temple of Kom Ombo, dedicated to two gods, Horus the falcon and Sobek the crocodile. MEALS B+L+D

OCT 17 | Abu Simbel by Land + Water

Following breakfast, we'll depart for a comfortable drive to one of the most impressive sites of antiquity, the Temples of Abu Simbel (20), built to honor Ramses II, and his wife, Nefertari. We'll arrive for lunch at a family-run restaurant on the shore of Lake Nasser. Then, a small boat will take us along the shoreline to view these magnificent structures from the water from which they were rescued in the 1960's by UNESCO and the United States. We'll then explore them by land. We return to the Philae for a delightful dinner.

OCT 18 | Disembark + Fly back to Cairo

We'll disembark after breakfast. The High Dam at Aswan is an impressive achievement of modern-day Egypt. We'll visit by boat the lovely Temple of Philae (2), like Abu Simbel rescued from the rising waters of Lake Nasser. Now situated on its own island, this most charming of Egyptian temples dates from 370 BCE and is dedicated to the Goddess Isis. We'll also visit the modern, award-winning Nubian Museum before flying back to Cairo.

This evening we'll enjoy the 5-star **Waldorf Astoria**, conveniently near Cairo International Airport. We'll gather for a casual farewell dinner. MEALS B+L+D

OCT 19 | Farewell to Cairo

After breakfast, we'll be chauffeured to checkin throughout the morning for our onward flights. MEALS B


